

Drummond Hill Pool Rules

No one is allowed to enter the pool grounds until the posted opening time.

All families must check in daily when they enter the pool grounds and all guests must be tracked.

Members are not allowed to “save space” and should not reserve more than one seating location (e.g., a table and lounge chair).

No one is permitted in the pool unless a lifeguard is on duty.

Only children 6 years old and under are allowed in the wading pool and must be supervised at all times. Lifeguards do not monitor this area.

Only children 8 years old and under are allowed in the playground area and must be supervised at all times.

Diving in the shallow end of the pool is prohibited at all times.

Glass or other breakable containers of any kind are not permitted in the pool area.

Food and beverages are prohibited in the pool or within 4 feet of the pool edge.

No running inside the pool fence.

Pushing, wrestling or any unruly behavior is not allowed in the pool or close proximity.

Every member must clean up after themselves and deposit the trash in the receptacles provided.

There is absolutely no smoking of any kind (including cigarettes, cigars, vaping, etc.) permitted inside any pool fence or near the entrance. Please be considerate of others and dispose of cigarette butts properly.

Members are responsible for the actions of their guests and improper behavior can lead to membership cancellation according to the bylaws.

Lifeguards have authority during pool hours to enforce penalties for disregarding their instruction and/or not following the rules. Parents, not lifeguards, are responsible for their children's conduct.

Proper swim attire is required to enter the water.

Underage drinking is against the law and prohibited at all times.

Only managers and guards currently working are allowed in the guard shack.

Only one person is permitted on the diving board at a time.

Water accessories and games may be allowed in the pool at times when it's not crowded. Oversized flotation devices and boogie boards are not allowed. Do not leave floats unattended in the pool.

Children must be 11 years old and able to pass the following swimming test (administered by a Drummond Hill pool lifeguard) before they can be left at the pool alone without adult supervision. This rule applies to both members and guests.

- a. Swimming one length of the pool
- b. Floating, bobbing and treading water for one minute
- c. Picking up an object from the bottom of the pool in 5ft' of water.

Leak-proof diapers are required on untrained children in both the wading pool and the main pool areas.

Any person having an obvious communicable disease, skin eruption, fungus infections, ear, eye, nose or throat infection, or wearing bandages may not use the pool (Board of Health' H-7).

All sand from the volleyball court must be rinsed off with hose provided before entering the pool area or pool.

No pets are permitted within the pool area at any time.

Chewing gum is not permitted in the pool area.

Do not use vulgar or inappropriate language out of respect for those around you.

No skateboards, scooters, lacrosse sticks, or water guns are permitted in the pool area.

The diving board may be closed at times for swimming in the diving area but permission to swim must be obtained from the lifeguard on duty.

Every effort must be made to respect the rights and privacy of the owners of property surrounding the pool, the pool grounds, shrubs, parking lot and fields. Trespassing on the residential properties surrounding the pool is prohibited.

Membership fees are not refundable after the second Sunday in June.

Costs for repairs or replacement of any damaged pool property may be charged to the specific member responsible.

All personal injuries, regardless of how slight, must be reported immediately to a lifeguard on duty in order to ensure that an incident report is completed and the necessary actions are taken.

Swim Team meets are occasionally held, on Wednesday evenings/Saturday mornings in June and July, and the pool will be closed during these times.

Drummond Hill Pool reserves the right to direct people to park elsewhere when it is required to alleviate congestion and during regularly scheduled swim meets.

The pool can be rented for parties or events. See the pool manager or a Board member for information (restrictions may apply- such as curfews for music, etc.).

Grills are provided for member use, members are responsible for the monitoring of the grill, and that the grill is properly extinguished.

The refrigerator in the kitchen is provided for member usage. It is for the storage of food and non-alcoholic beverage items. Items left in refrigerator may be discarded at pool manager's discretion.

Although provisions for the safety of all members and guests have been made, Drummond Hill Pool, Inc. assumes no responsibility for anyone using the pool, basketball court, volleyball area and/or any other area on the pool grounds.

The pool staff is in charge at all times and has the complete authority to enforce all rules. They have the right to suspend the privileges of any member or guest who violates established rules for a period not to exceed 24 hours. The Board of Directors will determine when longer suspensions or expulsions are required.
